To amend title II of the Social Security Act to repeal the Government pension offset and windfall elimination provisions.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Social Security Fair-

5 ness Act".

6 SEC. 2. REPEAL OF GOVERNMENT PENSION OFFSET PROVI7 SION.

or 215(f)(9)(B)" in subparagraphs (C) and (D)(i) and in serting "paragraph (5) or (6) of section 215(f)".

4 SEC. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

5 The amendments made by this Act shall apply with 6 respect to monthly insurance benefits payable under title 7 II of the Social Security Act for months after December 8 2021. Notwithstanding section 215(f) of the Social Secu-9 rity Act, the Commissioner of Social Security shall adjust 10 primary insurance amounts to the extent necessary to take 11 into account the amendments made by section 3.
